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| Q1 | In Part C - Proposal Form the City asks for a Dunn & Bradstreet number. We do not have an account with Dunn & Bradstreet at this time however we see that our firm is listed and easily found when searched under our full legal name. Is it critical for us to set up an account with Dunn & Bradstreet for the purposes of this RFP?  |
| A1 | Having an account with Dunn & Bradstreet (D&B) is not required. If the Proponent does have an active D&B account, it is encouraged that such information is provided in the Proposal.   |
| Q2 | <p>With respect to Part B, Section 4.4(c), our insurance broker has encountered an issue - the RFP states the following:</p> <p><i>(c) a letter from the Proponent's insurer indicating whether (and, if not, then to what extent) the Proponent will be able to comply with the insurance requirements set out in Article 7 of the Form of Agreement (Part D) should the City enter into Agreement with the Proponent;</i></p> <p>However, Article 7 in Part D isn't about insurance. Article 6 is about insurance. Can you please provide written confirmation of what is required for the RFP so that we can provide it to our insurance broker?</p> |
| A2 | Refer to Article VI in the Form of Agreement (Part D).  |
