Re: OSIsoft PI system for the City's Dedicated Fire Protection System

Notice is hereby given by the City of Vancouver ("City") of its intent to contract with OSIsoft LLC for the purchase of the OSIsoft PI System and their Software Reliance Program. OSIsoft, LLC is the sole maker of the PI System and the sole provider of the Software Reliance Program. The City also intends to contract with OSIsoft Canada ULC for installation of the software and training.

Description:

The contract is to provide a system that connects to multiple interfaces and collects high-frequency data from multiple formats, standards and conventions, both time-series and event-based, from multiple systems and sources. To maintain the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) standard, the City requires an upgrade of its GE Historian system as it has reached capacity and is no longer the City's SCADA standard. The City currently utilizes the OSIsoft PI system to assist in managing its SCADA system and wishes to scale up the use of the OSIsoft PI system to replace the GE Historian system.

The contract with OSIsoft, LLC will be for a three year term, with an option of two additional one-year extensions at the sole discretion of the City.

The contract is valued at approximately \$46,725 USD for the hardware and software, \$9,200 CAD for installation and training, and \$7,000 USD annually for support & maintenance.
