Notice is hereby given by the City of Vancouver ("City") of its intent to contract with Sport BC for the supply of the following services:

Organize participatory all-ages sport event programming for July 1, 2017 in celebration of Canada Day. With renovation of the North Plaza of the Vancouver Art Gallery recently complete, the City has identified a need for family-friendly programming on July 1 to celebrate Canada Day and enliven this newly refurbished important public plaza at the heart of the city. To that end, the City has identified Sport BC to mount an all-ages sports day that supports City goals for a healthy city and active living.

Sport BC will be responsible for all aspects of planning and mounting the event including:

- Coordination with Provincial sport organizations to select candidate sports
- Securing all necessary staff, volunteers and equipment for the event
- Outreach and communication, plus other duties as required.

Sport BC is a non-profit sport federation, representing over 50 Provincial Sport Organizations in British Columbia. Due to their unique relationships with the broad range of Provincial Sport Organizations, they are solely positioned to develop and deliver the desired concept for sport programming.

The contract is valued at approximately \$75,000.
