QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS NO. 1

Q1.1	We were able to download the drawings but the dimensions of the "Work Area" that are in red are not clearly marked in length and width.
A1.1	The approximate dimensions of the work area are 200m x183m. Exact limits of work boundaries will be determined on site prior to the commencement of construction activities.
Q1.2	Refer to: Pricing table item 2.1 showing Cash Allowance for Supply and Installation of HealthBeat Fitness Equipment.
	What exactly does cash allowance mean? Will the city want us to purchase specific equipment from Habitat?
A1.2	Cash allowance simply defined, is the pool of money that the City has allocated for the purchase of a specific item, in this case, fitness equipment. When Proponent fills out the pricing table, the bid price will include the cash allowance. This means, the Proponent as Prime Contractor, will carry this amount and purchase the equipment from Habitat. Please refer to section GC4.1 CASH ALLOWANCES in the general conditions for additional information.
Q1.3	Can Marathon Surfaces, Manufacturers specification and contact information be added to the documents for the poured in place rubber surfacing.
	There isn't a manufacturer or a spec for the rubber surfacing specified in the documents. Attached is our specification for the Poured Rubber surfacing which is the product that is in the drawing (without a spec or manufacturer). See attachment.
A1.3	Landsafe surfacing by Marathon Surfaces is an acceptable material. However, other poured in place rubber surfacing products meeting the requirements outlined in section 2.4 of Technical Specification 11 68 13 Fitness Equipment may be considered.
