ISSUED ON JULY 19, 2019

Q1	How close is the street pile to the railing?
A1	The exterior face of the sheet pile wall is more than 10 meters (measured horizontally) to the closest CP rails, located below the site.
Q2	Who owns the manhole? How old is the manhole?
A2	The Greater Vancouver Sewerage & Drainage District (GVSⅅ) is owned by Metro Vancouver.
Q3	What is the length of rods?
A3	Please refer to the structural drawings for the varying length of rods. Drawing S-053, note 2, indicates that the "minimum anchor unbonded length shall be 3000mm". Refer to S-051 and S-052 sections for the minimum bonded lengths.
Q4	Where have the boreholes been done?
A4	Please refer to the geotechnical report for the location of the bore holes (page 17, Figure 1).
