Clarification	Discharge of Trench Dewatering to Sewers:  As a general rule, water should be treated to meet the requirements of the Sewer and Watercourse By-Law such that it can be discharged to the storm sewer.  In the event contractors are unable to adequately treat contaminants in the water, contractors can potentially discharge to the Sanitary Sewer. Contractors shall obtain a
