CURRENTLY READS:

1. Part A Section 4.10 says:

4.10 The City is willing to consider any Proposal from two or more Proponents that wish to form a consortium solely for the purpose of submitting a joint Proposal in response to the RFP, provided that they disclose the names of all members of the consortium and all members complete and execute a Proposal Form (Part C). Nonetheless, the City has a strong preference for proposals submitted by a single Proponent, including a Proponent that would act as a **general contractor** and use subconsultants as required.

REPLACE WITH:

4.10 The City is willing to consider any Proposal from two or more Proponents that wish to form a consortium solely for the purpose of submitting a joint Proposal in response to the RFP, provided that they disclose the names of all members of the consortium and all members complete and execute a Proposal Form (Part C). Nonetheless, the City has a strong preference for proposals submitted by a single Proponent, including a Proponent that would act as a **Prime Consultant** and use subconsultants as required.
