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| Q1 | Would you be able to give me a current estimate on the City's annual spend for all tires and related services?   |

| Q2 | On your tire requirement pages you are asking for Light Duty 'All Weather' tires under 17.5". Can you please confirm your definition of 'All Weather' - does this mean tire requires the 3PMS (three-peak-mountain-snowflake) symbol? Or when an 'All Weather' tire is not available, especially in the P-metric sizes, will an 'All-Season' tire (NO 3PMS) suffice?   |
| A2 | <b>All light duty must have 3PMS. If none available in the desired size. Minimum spec must be M+S.</b><br><b>No "all-season" tires.</b>  |
| Q3 | In the Pricing Matrix Requirement A tab, it asks for us to match the brand and tread or another tire that is equivalent or exceeds the tire on the spreadsheet. Its also asks for all tires 17.5" and less on Requirement A to be All Weather Rated. Some of the tires listed like the first one is a LT225/75R16 Michelin LTX MS2 which we can provide no problem, but its not an All Weather tire. Should I quote out a similar tire which is All Weather Rated, or will I be safe just to quote out the tire that is listed which is an All Season? |
| A3 | <b>Must be equivalent to all-weather (3PMS) tires. If none available in size. Minimum spec must be M+S.</b>  |
