Q1	Does CofV need bidders to provide support identification of new sites? We are trying to find clarification on if the scope of work includes RFP bidders identifying ideal site locations for chargers (i.e. e-Hubs) or if the City is taking care of that.
A1	It is the City's preference to select its preferred sites within the broader context of our EV Ecosystem Strategy and other relevant policies. However, should a proponent's business model or expertise include site selection on the City's behalf, proponents are welcome to suggest specific locations in their proposals for the City's consideration. If a proponent suggests certain locations, please include the reasons why and how such proponent believes each location meets the City's EV Ecosystem Strategy and other relevant policy goals. Proponents should be aware that any information provided in respect of a location will not be considered confidential and such information may be used by the City if the City awards the contract to another proponent. It is ultimately up to the City to approve each location.
