## 1) SPECIFICATION UPDATE

#### **CURRENTLY READS:**

Specifications Section 3.3:

The Service Line at 3608 10<sup>th</sup> Ave W must be replaced.

#### **REPLACE WITH:**

Specifications Section 3.3:

The successful Proponent is to conduct a site survey at 3608 10<sup>th</sup> Ave W, and provide an accurate quote to replace the service line at that time.

### 2) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON JAPANESE BEETLE

All soil removed within the regulated area (RA), map attached, requires a movement certificate year-round. Above ground plant material is regulated from June 15<sup>th</sup> to Oct 15<sup>th</sup> and also requires a movement certificate during those dates. Turf falls under the soil regulations and must be deep buried at the landfill which generally, requires 36-48 hours notice to prepare.

Ideally, the soil is left on-site and placed back once the work is completed. As an option, the soil may also be moved within the RA from job site to job site. Once the work is done, tools and equipment should be swept or cleaned before being used in an area outside the regulated area.




