

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONTRACT

**Re: Supply, Delivery and Install Jellicoe Rail Concrete Panels**

Notice is hereby given by the City of Vancouver ("City") of its intent to contract with Canadian Pacific for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Jellicoe Rail Concrete Panels.

The City is required to rehabilitate and lengthen the Canadian Pacific railway crossings surface at 10.21 Marpole Spur/Jellicoe Street. After considering all options, the City has determined that it will achieve best value through procuring the rail concrete panels directly from Canadian Pacific.

In order to perform this work on the existing railway crossings surface at 10.21 Marpole Spur/Jellicoe Street location, the City has identified and specified the following scope of work on an as-if-and-when required basis:

- The old asphalt approach 6 feet from edge of rail at the railway crossing will be removed and disposed of to either side of the railway track.
- 120 feet of old rail and 9 foot ties will be removed and replaced by 10 foot ties and new rail installed as required to support the wider concrete crossing panels.
- The new concrete panels will be installed and the approaches reinstalled to complete the rehab and railway crossing upgrade.

Canadian Pacific is agreeing to rehabilitate the railway "asset" (railway crossing) at the request of the City as the entry of any other uninvited persons on Canadian Pacific Property would be considered trespassing. The City's anticipated contract with Canadian Pacific for the supply, delivery and installation of the above components will have a term of approximately one (1) year, commencing October 15, 2021. The contract is valued at approximately \$170,000. This notice may represent the only official notice.
