Re: Updating and Improving Displays on 3rd Floor to Make City Hall A More Welcoming, Inclusive & Accessible Place For All

Notice is hereby given by the City of Vancouver ("City") of its intent to contract with Museum of Vancouver for their curatorial, fabrication, and conservation services to update and improve the displays and photos in the public areas of the third floor of City Hall to address gaps in diversity and representation

The 3rd floor foyer of City Hall currently displays official artifacts and photos that generally represent the colonial history of Vancouver. There are few display items or installations that reflect the diversity of Vancouver's population, including contributions and experiences of Indigenous Peoples and other racialized members of our community.

This project presents an opportunity to tell a richer and more complete set of stories about the past and present contributions of Vancouver residents in ways that better reflect our population.

The contract is valued at approximately \$13,469 with an option to renew for two (2) successive - 1 (one) year extensions upon written approval from the City.
